Book accommodations

New Braunfels offers beautiful and romantic boutique hotels like <u>Sophie's Gasthaus</u>, <u>Prince Solms Inn</u>, <u>Gruene River Hotel & Retreat</u> and <u>Gruene Mansion Inn</u> perfect for your escape. Check out the newly renovated <u>Faust Hotel</u> reopening in Spring 2026. If you prefer the familiarity and amenities of a national hotel brand, book <u>Courtyard by Marriott</u> or one of these hotels.

Day 1: Discover Downtown

Sleep in and enjoy a lazy morning over coffee in your hotel. In New Braunfels you can be where you want in just a few minutes and we specialize in low stress.

For breakfast head to <u>2tarts</u> for homemade sweet and savory treats and coffee. <u>Krause's</u> and <u>The Mess Around at Crosswalk</u> both also offer great menus and ambiance.

Saturdays in <u>Downtown New Braunfels</u> always start with the <u>Farmers Market</u>. Meet over 60 vendors who offer locally produced food, home and personal care items, pet supplies and more.



<u>Huisache</u> is a perfect, quaint spot for lunch and is a go-to for locals. For a Cajun flair, you two will love the menu and vibe of <u>McAdoo's Seafood Co. & Oyster Bar</u>.

If pickleball is your thing check out <u>The Courthouse</u> for fun times and great food!

Have a drink and appetizer at <u>Muck & Fuss</u> before dinner. Grab a glass of wine and charcuterie at <u>The Clubhouse</u> a fabulous wine bar with a cozy vibe. Enjoy wine and tapas at <u>Favorite Neighbor</u>. Make a reservation at <u>Myron's Prime Steakhouse</u> or <u>Cody's</u> for an unforgettable romantic dinner. Both are in the heart of <u>Downtown</u>.

After dinner, see what's playing at the <u>Brauntex Theatre</u> - downtown's home for live music, performing arts, comedy shows and touring acts. Lots of shows sell out, so plan ahead! Round out the evening downstairs at <u>Sidecar</u>, a dimly-lit underground sanctuary, for a cocktail and enjoy the ambience while listening to live music in an intimate setting.

Day 2: Explore Gruene

before you head over to <u>Gruene</u>. If you want to stop
on the quick drive over, grab a table at <u>Buttermilk</u>

Hill Country cookin'.

Make your way to <u>Gruene Historic District</u>. If it's a <u>Gruene Market Days</u> weekend you two are in for some amazing shopping from over 100 artisans who sell their one-of-a-kind items. Otherwise never fear, Gruene is known for plenty of <u>unique shopping</u> in a setting just as special. Be sure to visit <u>The Pomegranate</u>,



<u>Gruene Outfitters, Fickle Pickles</u>, <u>Gruene Hat Company</u>, and we could go on and on so check out the other stores too!

For lunch, get a table by the windows at <u>Gruene River Grill</u> or outside, y'all will love the view overlooking the Guadalupe River. Or try the fun ambiance and creative menu in the heart of Gruene at <u>Mozie's</u>. After dining, it's time for souvenirs.
